5. Carbon Reduction Projects

Brief description of some of our completed carbon reduction projects

- i) We operate an Environmental Management System which since 07/10/04 has been certified by SGS United Kingdom Limited as complying with ISO 14001.
- ii) We are a member of Architects Declare, a network of architectural practices across the UK committed to addressing the climate and biodiversity emergency.
- iii) Recycled 100% of our waste paper, plastic, tin & glass.
- iv) Changed to holding at least 95% of our in-house meetings via Teams rather than in person
- v) Making sustainability/carbon reduction a standard agenda item for our whole office monthly meetings.

In future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- i) Further reducing emissions from business travel.
- ii) Maintaining a programme of at least 4 Sustainability/carbon reduction training sessions yearly.
- iii) Continue to collaborate with our IT consultants to understand more the environmental impact of IT/digital equipment.
